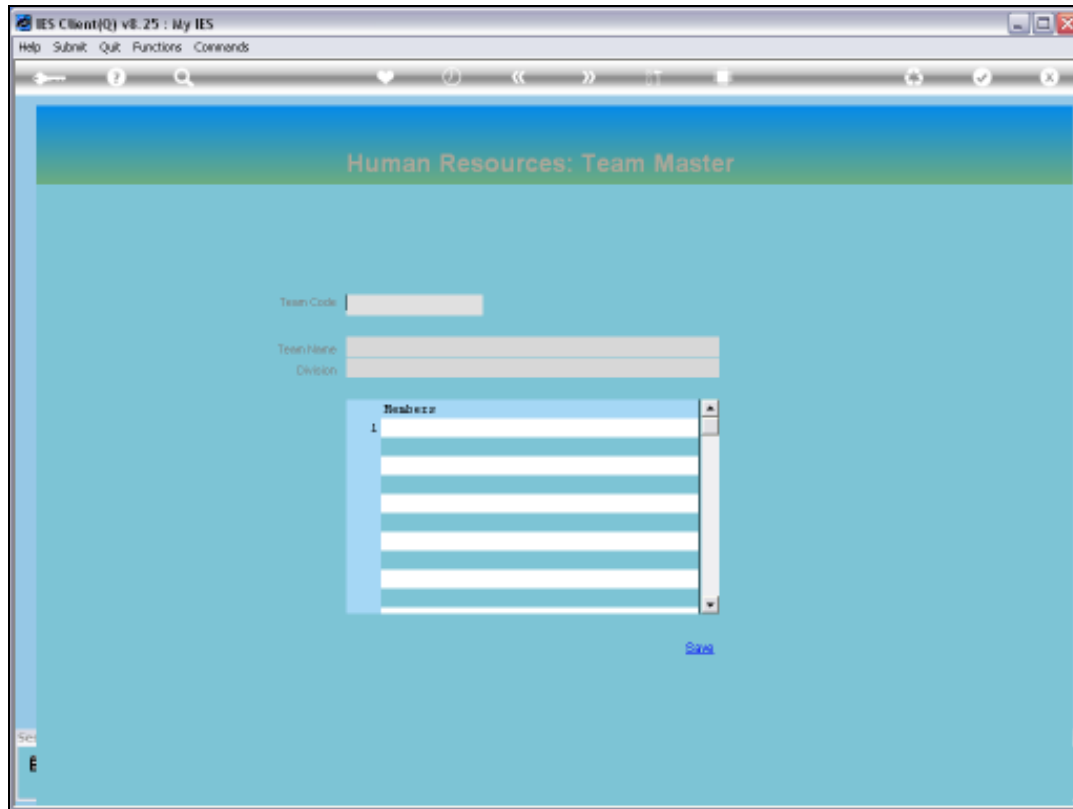




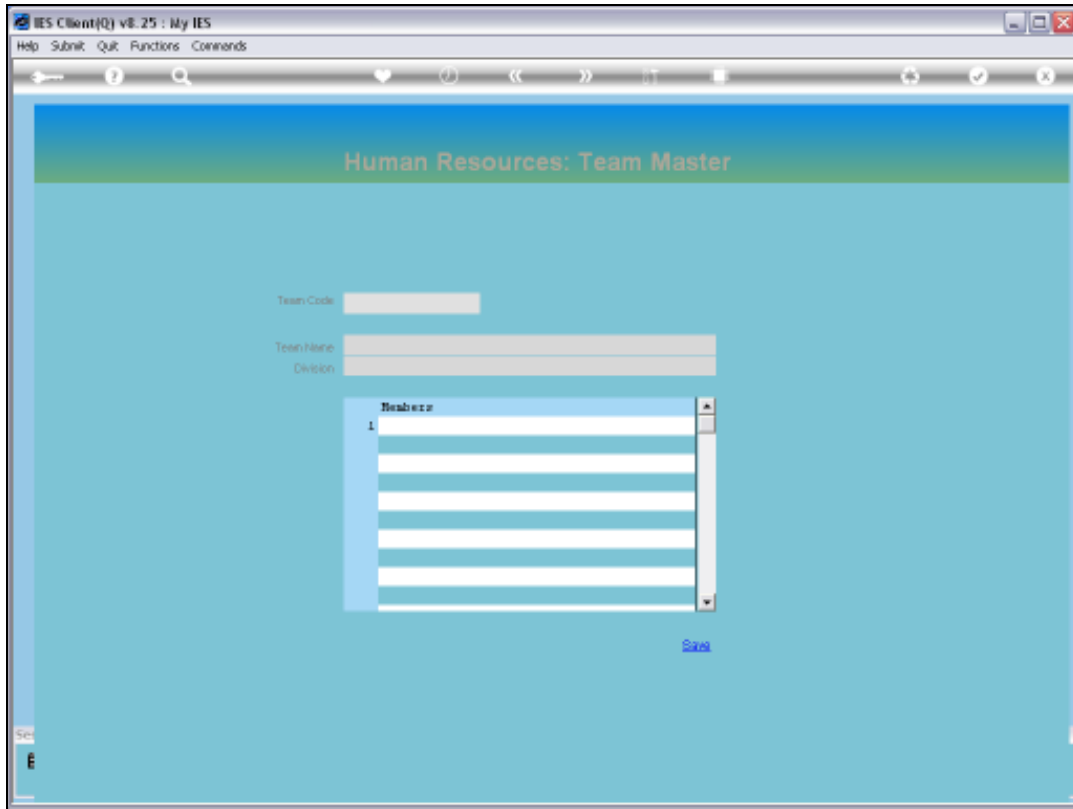
Slide 1

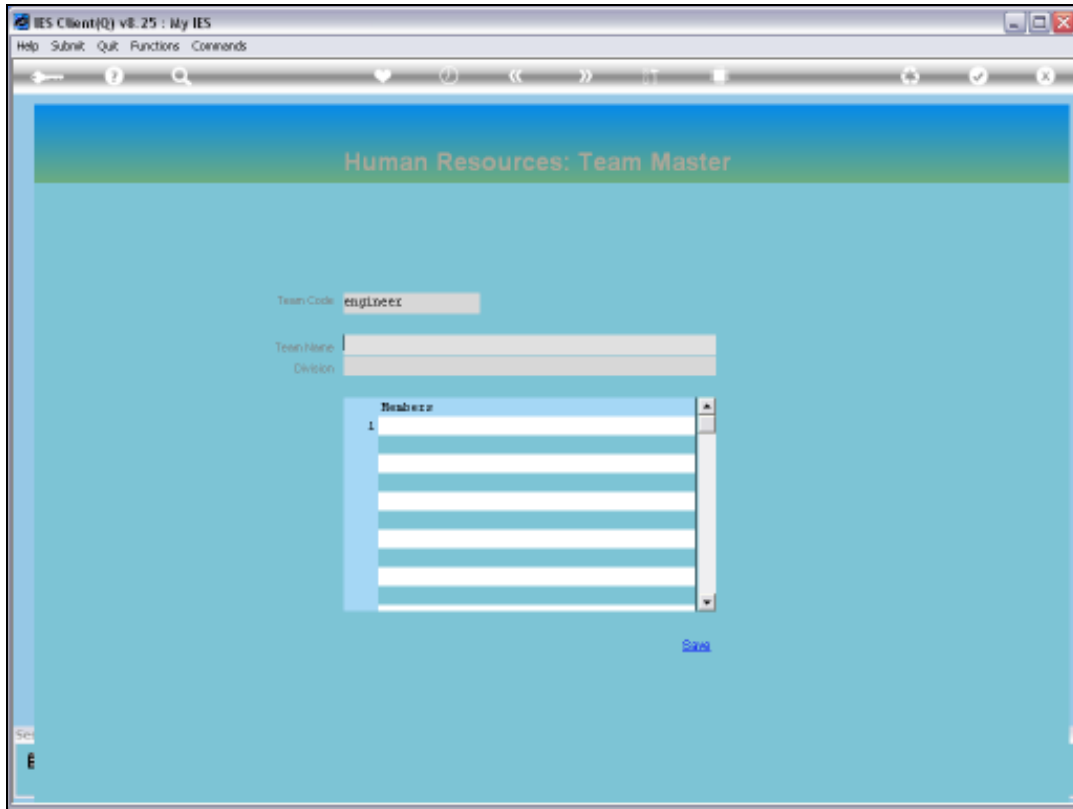

Slide notes: A Team is defined by a Code, a Team Name and by indicating which Division it is part of, because Teams are further organized into Divisions.

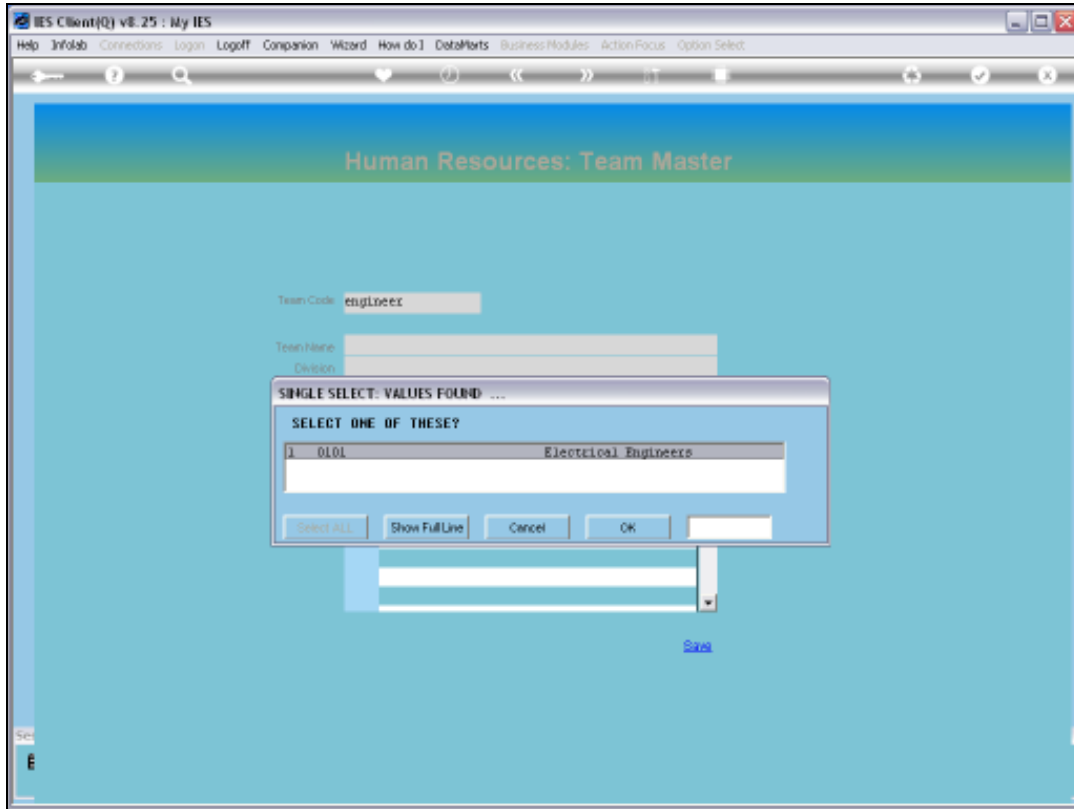

Slide notes: Whereas we selected this Team Master option from the Job Costing Menu, we will show now that it is also available at the Planned Maintenance menu.



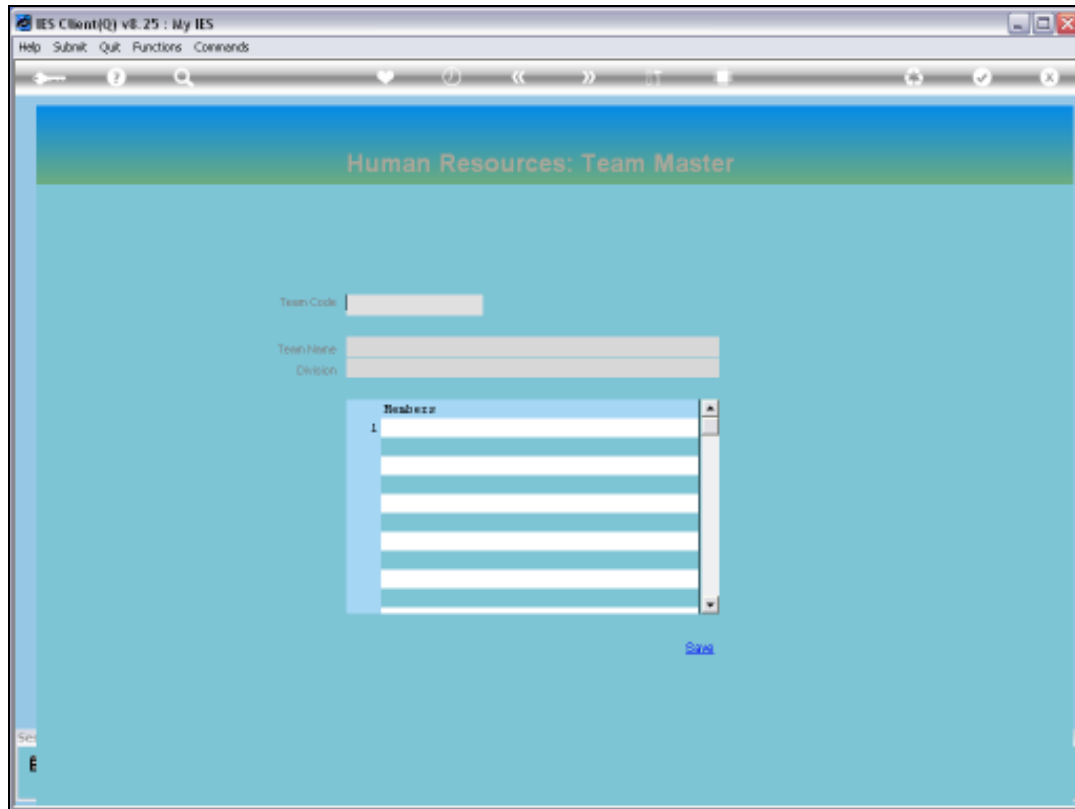
